## A Note from Our Pastor

Dear Friends,

One of my favorite quotes for the Easter season comes from the late and great Scottish preacher, James Stewart. He wrote these words in his book, [A Faith to Proclaim](#):

*"This is our Gospel. For this is what Christianity essentially is – a religion of Resurrection. This is what every worshipping congregation is intended in the purpose of God to be – a community of the Resurrection. This is the basic character of every act of public worship – a proclamation of the Resurrection. And this is what the Gospel offers to our dark and ruined chaos of a world, where people peering into the future are daunted by the well-nigh impossible task of creating order out of confusion and life out of death: the power of the Resurrection."*

We have eight special days coming soon – the days of Palm Sunday through Easter Sunday. These are days in which we especially remember and celebrate the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus the Messiah, Savior, Son of God. I hope you are planning to be a part of our Palm/Passion Sunday celebration, our Maundy Thursday communion service and our Easter Sunday worship. We will remember and experience anew the gracious love of God, "who gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him will not perish, but have everlasting life." (John 3.16)

We will realize again that we are the people for whom Christ came, Christ died, and Christ rose again. In his suffering death for us, we find forgiveness. In his powerful resurrection, we find God's victory over sin, death and even the fear of death. As Jesus Christ is raised from the dead, so we are raised from defeat, despair, dejection and discouragement. We are lifted up so that we may serve and honor Jesus Christ in all that we say and do.

What a joy to believe and to follow our crucified and resurrected Savior and Lord! Join in the celebrations!
