## 2022 Stewardship Letter

"You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead, they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." Matthew 5:14-16:

Dear FPC Community,

The poet Maya Angelou said "This a wonderful day. I've never seen this one before." How appropriate an introduction for the theme of our 2022 Stewardship Program, "Always Giving, Always Thankful."

In 2022 we will continue to focus on Stewardship as part of our daily lives. We have all seen that the world in which we live has changed dramatically and continues to change at an accelerating pace. How do we, as Christians, make sense of this and stay true to our faith, beliefs, and values?

Angelou's simple statement reminds me of the need to exclaim "LOOK UP!" as we all sometimes become fixated with our eyes looking downward at our phones and tablets. Ever notice that when you are in an elevator, waiting in line, at an airport, etc., more people are looking down at their devices than at each other or what is going on around them? And how many times have you either called out "LOOK UP!" or been tempted to do so at people walking down the street or headed your way who are not looking where they are going but are instead glued to the little electronic screen in their hands!

This year Session Committee leaders will "LOOK UP" by sharing with the congregation the functions and activities of their respective groups to demonstrate aspects of "Stewardship" as applied to the work of committees. This particular approach broadens the concept of Stewardship while having less emphasis on our "seeking dollars." We will increase transparency and communication with congregants in as many church functions as possible and practical. You will see changes in ways we communicate with members and interested persons including social media, email, and possibly even personal messages.

So, in 2022, our challenge will be to LOOK UP!" And I suspect when we do, we will find ourselves "Always Giving, Always Thankful."
