## **SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES**

Darlington County Habitat for Humanity believes that people should have a simple, durable place to live in dignity and safety. Habitat offers a "hand up," not a "hand out" because the homeowners provide 300 hours of sweat equity and pay a mortgage payment. Habitat has built 57 homes since it started in Darlington County 27 years ago. Also, for each home built, Habitat contributes financially to building shelters in Haiti. FPC has provided financial support, volunteer builders and painters plus leadership on the Habitat board.

The Ukraine ministry is designed to help war-torn citizens from Ukraine safe harbor in the United States more specifically in Hartsville SC.
